Shepway Council are considering selling Council owned land on Weymouth Road in front of the Bowls Club for a "residential development" of up to FIVE houses.

The plan came to light when Lib Dem Councillor **Peter Gane** was asked his views on the Tory & 'People First' Council plan.

Peter Gane said:

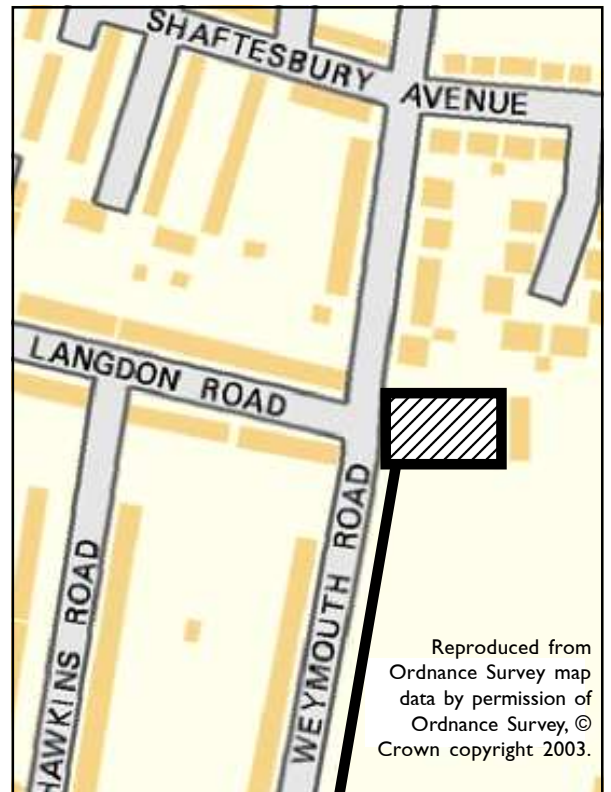
"I can't begin to understand how any Cheriton Councillor could support this move.
