

Lydd Airport - fears grow

Lydd Airport management are expected to submit a formal application to extend the runway within weeks.

Plans recently announced by Lydd Airport could mean noisy jet aircraft taking off and landing every 20 to 30 minutes. The expansion will cause a huge increase in traffic through New Romney.

Lib Dem Toni Powell said, "It is vital that local people have their say on this proposed expansion. I believe that this expansion would cause huge damage to the lives of local people."

Local Lib Dems, Green Party and Friends of the Earth have joined forces as the 'Keep the Marsh Special' group to help local people campaign against the expansion.
